

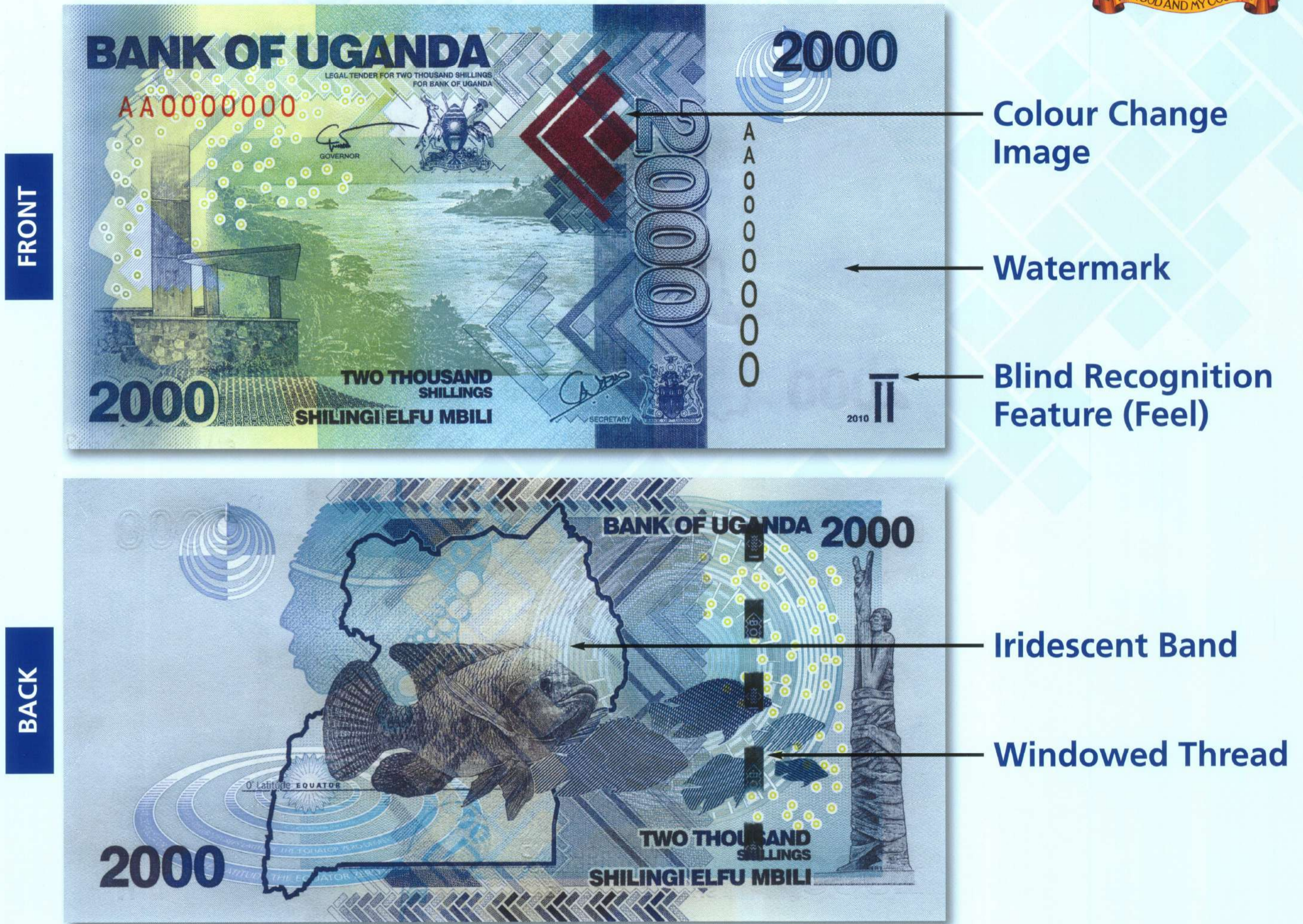

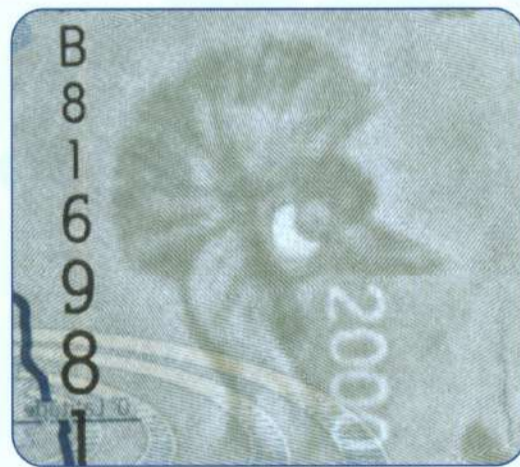


Security features contained in the Shs. 1000, Shs. 2000 & Shs. 5000 banknotes



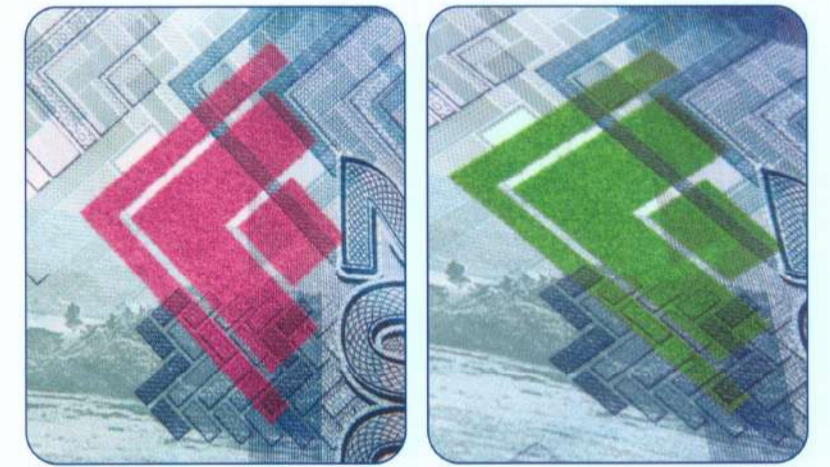
Watermark

All notes of the new series show the same image of the crested crane. Look for the light area near the eye and the dark area above the beak. The denomination is highlighted.



Colour Change Image

The prominent purple pattern changes to green when the note is tilted away from you.



Windowed Thread

The thread changes from red to green when the note is tilted away from you. Additionally, when held to the light, the thread is continuous and includes the letters BOU with the symbol for the blind.



Iridescent Band

Moving the note around shows a hidden shiny stripe pattern. In every banknote pattern there are the letters BOU and the denomination figure.



If in doubt, compare with a known genuine banknote
